## Position Overview

Michigan State University is the Pioneer Land Grant University and is an international leader in agricultural education. Michigan State University Extension (MSUE) is recognized for excellence in teaching and learning, with 4-H serving as the foundational youth development program of MSUE. This position is an integral part of the MSUE Children & Youth Institute, the Science work team, and holds a joint assignment in the Department of Animal Science. This individual is responsible for networking and collaborating with faculty in the Department of Animal Science, the College of Veterinary Medicine, and the Agriculture and Agribusiness Institute to help ensure programming is aligning with current research and educational efforts in the animal science, veterinary and animal agriculture areas.

The position will provide statewide leadership of the 4-H Livestock (beef, sheep, and swine) and Veterinary Science Programming areas within MSUE. The 4-H livestock and the veterinary science programs include animal care education, career awareness, work force preparation and leadership development related to agriculture and the animal sciences. The candidate will work with MSUE and MSU faculty and staff, 4-H volunteers, and stakeholders to develop, implement and evaluate programs that provide opportunities for youth to develop leadership potential, self-esteem, values, citizenship responsibility and productive capacity. The position is expected to foster relationships with the livestock and veterinary science industries, youth educators, and diverse communities throughout Michigan.
