



**Agribusiness and Agriscience – (Position # 102080)**  
**Assistant or Associate Professor in Agricultural  
Education**

The School of Agribusiness and Agriscience at Middle Tennessee State University invites applications for a 10-month, tenure-track position in Agricultural Education at the assistant or associate professor level. Applicants must have a doctorate degree in Agricultural Education or a closely related field by the start date of August 1, 2018. The successful candidate will be responsible for teaching undergraduate courses in agricultural education and other agricultural courses in their discipline. The candidate is also expected to develop courses that enhance the current agricultural education curriculum, including courses in the recently approved Master of Education in Administration and Supervision (Agricultural Education Leadership Concentration). Research, public service, student advising, and coordinating the agricultural education teacher licensure program are further requirements for this position. Effective teaching, organizational, and communication skills are essential. Preference will be given to candidates with demonstrated excellence in undergraduate education, applied research, and public service.

The School serves approximately 500 undergraduate students and offers baccalaureate programs in agribusiness, animal science, and plant and soil science, with agricultural education concentrations (secondary education minor) available for each of these programs. The School also offers graduate degrees in Horse Science (M.S.) (concentrations in equine education, equine physiology, and industry management) and Administration and Supervision (M.Ed.) with a concentration in Agricultural Education Leadership.
