Assistant Professor of Agricultural Education

Position:

Assistant Professor of Agricultural Education and Agricultural Sciences, full-time, nine-month, tenure track appointment, 75% teaching, 25% research.

Position Summary:

The Department of Agricultural Education and General Agriculture at Oregon State University is seeking an exceptional candidate for a tenure track faculty member focusing on agricultural education. This is a full time, 9 month appointment, 75% teaching, 25% research. This person will provide innovative leadership in Agricultural Education while also engaging and providing service to our Agricultural Sciences, Agricultural Leadership, and developing Agricultural Communications programs. The individual will teach, recruit, and mentor undergraduate and graduate students, conduct a nationally recognized research and scholarly program and engage in service activities that emphasize Oregon secondary agricultural science and technology programs. The position will support the University, College of Agricultural Sciences, and Department of Agricultural Education and General Agriculture strategic plans.

College of Agricultural Sciences faculty are committed to enhancing student success by engaging students in quality academic, research, internships, global studies, and other experiential learning opportunities. Positions with primary responsibility for extension and outreach are likewise committed to learner success through programming appropriate for diverse audiences.

Minimum/Required Qualifications:

- A doctorate degree in agricultural education or closely related field
- Evidence of successful teaching experience in secondary agriculture education
- Demonstrated commitment to promoting and enhancing diversity.
- Demonstrated success and commitment to effective teaching, research and scholarship, and service
- Demonstrated skills in verbal and written communication
- Demonstration of collaborative work
- Must pass the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission fingerprint-based background check prior to start date

Preferred Qualifications:

- Demonstrated ability to teach in other department areas including agricultural sciences, leadership, and communications
- Evidence of a publication record commensurate with a tenure-track position
- Demonstrated success in undergraduate and graduate student advising
- Demonstrated ability to work with a variety of types of learners in diverse settings such as online education, continuing professional development, etc.
- Demonstrated ability to collaborate with local, state, and national stakeholders
- Record of/commitment to work with underrepresented/underserved students or other audiences.

Duties:

- Teach undergraduate and graduate courses (on-campus and by distance) primarily in agricultural education with potential to include Agricultural Leadership or Agricultural Sciences
- Advise undergraduate and graduate students
- Assist with undergraduate and graduate student recruitment
- Supervise pre-service teachers
- Conduct a focused program of scholarship and publication in concert with priorities of the department
- Develop a successful record of extramural grant funding, actively seeking contracts and grant funding to support his/her program
- Participate in graduate education, chair, and serve on graduate committees
