The University of Wisconsin– River Falls invites applications for a Laboratory Farm Director position in the College of Agriculture, Food and Environmental Sciences (CAFES). The successful candidate will collaborate with faculty and college leadership to achieve a balance between the educational mission of the farm and the economics of production agriculture. The individual is responsible for managing the budget, personnel, and daily operations of the Mann Valley Laboratory Farm (dairy, beef, swine, sheep, cropping) and the Campus Laboratory Farm (equine). The Laboratory Farm Director will serve as direct supervisor of the Lab Farm Associate/livestock and cropping, UW Agriculture Supervisor/dairy enterprise and the Faculty Associate/equine enterprise, and strive to create a positive and educational environment for the student workforce, which consists of approximately 60 students each year.

The Laboratory Farms are used heavily to meet the teaching mission of the college, and both are only minutes from campus. There are five departments within the College, which has a total enrollment of over 1450 undergraduate students.
