A MS degree in Animal Science or related field is highly preferred. Position would advise first year students, teach a variety of animal science course which may include first year experience, junior seminar, senior seminar, or any other course deemed necessary. Candidates that are ABD at the time of application will also be considered. Candidate must possess terminal degree at time of appointment. Prior teaching experience is preferred. A willingness and desire to advise undergraduate students in Animal Science is desired. Rank as instructor while salary would be commensurate with qualifications. Candidates must be committed to a student-centered education.
