Biology Faculty Position Announcement

The University of Mount Olive is private faith-based liberal arts institution offering degrees in biology, biomedical science, biotechnology, and environmental and natural resources. The University has over 1,000 traditional undergraduate students and the School of Agriculture and Biological Sciences over 300 of these attendees seeking undergraduate degrees in agricultural and biological fields of study. The campus is located in eastern NC about one hour east of Raleigh and one hour west of Wilmington located on the NC coast.

The School of Agriculture and Biological Sciences seeks applicants for a full-time 9-month faculty position in the Department of Environmental and Biological Sciences starting in Fall of 2021. The ideal candidate will be expected to teach courses in general biology for majors and non-majors and courses in the newly created biotechnology curriculum, and other areas of study consistent with academic qualifications. The candidate will also be expected to provide academic advising to students, participate in club activities, and integrate into the campus community. Candidates must have a strong commitment to effective teaching and mentoring undergraduates. Review of applications will begin immediately and continue until the position is filled.
