

Position: Assistant Lecturer - Agricultural and Applied Economics

The Department of Agricultural and Applied Economics at the University of Wyoming seeks applicants for a lecturer position. Preferred candidates will have an interest in teaching undergraduate courses in, but not limited to: agribusiness management, marketing, sales, banking, finance, risk management, economic decision-making, or related subject topics. This full-time, 9-month appointment will have responsibilities for teaching (95%) and service (5%).

The Department of Agricultural and Applied Economics has one of the largest degree programs in the College of Agriculture, Life Sciences, and Natural Resources. The Department offers one undergraduate degree, a B.S. in Agricultural Business, with three concentration options in Agribusiness Management, Livestock Business Management, and Farm and Ranch Management. The Department seeks candidates who are eager to contribute to their undergraduate program and foster the department's commitment to diversity and inclusion in higher education.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

The successful candidate will teach undergraduate courses in core agribusiness topics. Specific teaching responsibilities and courses will be established based on departmental need and candidate background. The candidate will assist the department in ensuring success for students in agricultural jobs of the future.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: A Master's degree or equivalent. Candidates must be committed to undergraduate education.
